- All online giving platforms have associated fees. Typically, increases in giving more than cover any fees incurred.
- Many church software programs connect with online giving platforms which results in less time being spent on data entry for tithes, offerings or special projects.
- Online giving allows your parishioners to give even on Sundays when they don't attend the worship service.
