Covenant Children's Ministries, formerly Covenant Children's Home and Family Services, located in Princeton, IL will be accepting grant applications from Evangelical Covenant Churches and church affiliated organizations who have programs providing services to at-risk children and youths. Eligible applicants must be an ECC church or must be collaborating with an ECC church for the program for which you will be submitting your application.

Applications are available on the CCM website and will be accepted through March 5, 2018. Eligible proposals can be for summer programs, school based programs or they can be for year round community based programs.

Covenant Children's Home and Family Services began as a response to the needs of children who were without parents or whose parents were not able to adequately provide for their needs. Covenant Children's Ministries is committed to carrying on this generous and compassionate response to children in need through the work of the Covenant church today. If your church or organization has been a previous grant recipient, you may re-apply, if you have fulfilled all of the necessary grant reporting requirements. We want to help your organization deliver efficient and effective services to children and youth at risk. We see these grant opportunities as a way to achieve that goal.
